Application Form Footnotes:

- ¹ Dressage tests can be either (a) test from a single judge or (b) the combined score from all judges. If combined penalty scores from all judges are used, it is acceptable if some of them judged in more than one of the events submitted (i.e., you do not have to consider the individual judges when using the combined score). However, if individual (single judge) scores are used, then the single judge cannot be used more than two times. If judges names cannot be established on one of the two websites mentioned below - but it can be shown as an ADS or USEF or FEI recognized event, just the event's result sheet will be acceptable too. No single drive may be submitted as more than one result for a given level nor may a single drive be submitted as a result for more than one level. In short – one drive is one result.
- ² Penalty points as calculated in combined driving
- ³ The maximum points and the total points given are found on the dressage tests after collective remarks
- ⁴ Not necessary if providing penalty points score. Necessary if providing percentage score, and for ADT tests and other Training and Preliminary level tests that do not have POM - Presentation on the Move.
