House Rule Pleasure Classes: International, Red Light/Green Light

House Rule Class Rules: INTERNATIONAL CLASS; competitors depict a turnout from a particular country. Turnout consists of equines, harness, driver, passengers and grooms. Aim to be as authentic as possible. 70% turnout quality and authenticity, 30% manners, way of going.

Red Light/Green Light Class: Driven by insured senior driver with a youth passenger wearing helmet, having signed waiver. The youth passenger walks the cones course prior to competing and then directs the driver over the course, answering questions at designated intervals on carriage driving, fastest time wins, all get ribbons and prize for winner

Secondary Event Details: Dressage: training, preliminary and intermediate

CDE cones course: training, preliminary and intermediate

Carriage Showcase: parade of different carriages with commentary on the turnouts for public education

Equine Showcase: parade of different equines involved in show with commentary on breed for public education.
