## PLEASURE DRIVE - PACE

Purpose: To test the driver on his skill in negotiating a cross country drive at a prescribed pace. To be driven over a marked course of any length (suggested 3-6 mi. or 5-10 km.) The mid-point is marked with a "half-way" marker. Penalties will be assessed for each second the competitor is over or under the time allowed. The last kilometer must be driven at a trot, breaks of pace will be penalized. Spares are required. Refer to Article 68 of the ADS Handbook for detailed class specifications.
