Briefings and Safety Check details

All turnouts MUST fill out and provide the safety questionnaire contained in registration packet. Present at the *SCHEDULED* SAFETY CHECK prior to first drive – NO EXCEPTIONS! You will be given a visible tag when you successfully pass the safety check. This tag is to be clearly displayed on your turnout throughout the weekend. Horses should be fit and well schooled for driving in open fields and along dirt roads, where you might encounter deer, riders, hikers, bikers, and possibly some automobiles and other carriages. (You do not need to go on public roads with automobile traffic in order to enjoy the grounds, but may have to cross them via tunnel or bridge.)

Accommodations & Camping

Stalls in the race barns are box stalls with rubber matted floors. Doors are sturdy, high, open mesh metal. THE ONLY BEDDING PERMITTED IS STRAW, which will be provided (one per horse). Sunday stall cleaning service will be provided on a paid basis; details on registration form. Other types of bedding are not allowed and can not be placed in manure pile. If this presents a veterinary problem for your animal(s), contact Organizer *prior to arrival* so a special permit can be authorized. Short of a major rain/wind storm, the barn roof overhang will provide reasonable protection for a tack box and some other equipment. There is no covered storage for carriages. The roof overhang on the barns offers only limited cover. Bring a tarp to cover your vehicle overnight (also good for stall clean-out) or store in your trailer to protect it from the weather.

Camping (RV site) with electric and water hook-ups- \$35 per night. Extremely limited availability Camping (field) with NO electric or water hook-up - \$20 per night. UNLIMITED

Clean bathrooms & showers with hot and cold water are available at the stables.

SAVE button:

Hitting the SAVE button does NOT send your Omnibus submission to your approving party (TD or Judge). SAVE will provide you a link that you will use to edit your submission PRIOR to sending to your approving party. Only when your submission is complete should you send the link to your TD or Judge. When your submission is approved by your TD or Judge please have your Official send an email to info@americandrivingsociety.org announcing approval. This indicates to us that your event is ready to be put on the ADS website. Your Omnibus submission will NOT be posted until we have an emailed confirmation from the approving official.

SUBMIT button:

Only for Organizer use

After your official approves the submission you can then hit the SUBMIT button. Once submitted if you need to make changes, email <u>info@americandrivingsociety.org</u> for the link to your completed Omnibus. If your changes are not related to the ADS rules (that require official's approval) you can just hit SUBMIT. At this point you must notify the ADS office via email to <u>info@americandrivingsociety.org</u> that your Omnibus needs to be reposted to the website. If your changes are related to a rule you should hit SAVE and use the link provided to you to request your official re-approve the Omnibus, after which they must notify info@americandrivingsociety.org in order for the new document to be posted.
